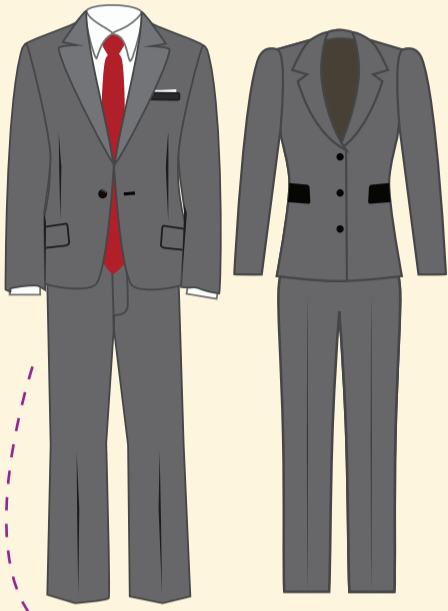

Carry a portfolio, professional bag or simple purse

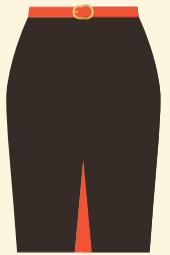
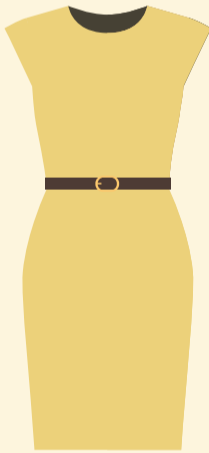
BRING ESSENTIALS ONLY!
