**BASIC JOB DESCRIPTION:** The Head Cheerleading Coach reports directly to the Assistant Director for Marketing and Promotions/ Event Manager and is responsible for recruiting, conducting tryouts, selecting, and training both men and women cheerleaders to perform at all home basketball contest, and selected away contest that may include basketball Conference Championship and post game play.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Bachelor's degree required and two years coaching experience preferred and /or proof of competency with directing tumbling activity; must have a commitment to the academic goals of the University; ability to work effectively with student-athletes, faculty, alumni and administrative staff; the possession and maintenance of a Florida driver's license and insurable driving record is required. Must have ability to lead effectively. Must be able to communicate effectively both in writing and orally.

**ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:** Leading a Division I cheerleading program; responsibilities include the administration of recruiting, fundraising, team management, team travel, compliance and budgeting; budget supervision, scholarship allocation, fundraising, and compliance with Sport Medicine policies and procedures; duties also include planning team training, coaching the team and recruiting; practice schedules, equipment and uniform purchase and care, squad discipline, recruitment. Furthermore, the coach is expected to coordinate with the marketing department to assist in the promotion of sporting events, and the event staff to coordinate the production of events in which they are participating. The head coach will need to be available to travel to any post season competition for which the team may qualify and participate in.

**WORKING CONDITIONS:** Duties require both indoor and outdoor work; physical ability to endure physically strenuous work-outs and physical exercise on a daily basis, including standing and/or walking for long periods, bending, stooping, lifting of up to fifty pounds; ability to work hours outside the normal University schedule; physical ability to travel; perceptual demands for sound, form and depth.
