ABOUT THE CAMPS

1. Position Camp - This camp offers players the chance to concentrate on the individual skills necessary to become either a better guard or a better post-player/big man. This camp is a must for players seeking to strengthen their natural position play or for the camper who wishes to learn more about a position where his skills are not as well defined.

For guards, the emphasis is on becoming a better shooter, ball-handler, passer and perimeter defender. The entire Stetson coaching staff, including former NAIA All-America point guard, Wylie Tucker, is well-versed in the skills and drills that enhance any guard's chances of becoming the best player that he can be.

For post-players/big men, the emphasis is on post offense and defense as well as post moves, rebounding, and other techniques that are essential to developing outstanding post play. Head Coach Derek Waugh, who ranks as one of the best post players in Furman University's basketball history, will be instrumental in making each camper the best post-player that he can be. Also, Coach Sebastian Singletary, who earned all conference honors for Stetson three times will work with the posts.

(DAY OR OVERNIGHT/AGES 10-18)

2. Shooting Camp - This camp offers players the opportunity to focus on improving their shooting ability. The Stetson coaching staff holds that practice does not make perfect, but rather perfect practice makes perfect. We emphasize teaching the proper form and the correct drills to our campers to hone their shooting skills. This camp is a must for young players seeking to establish solid fundamentals in order to become a successful shooter. We guarantee that each camper will have the opportunity to shoot over 5,000 critiqued shots during the 3 day camp. The Program has several shooting machines which enable a player to shoot over 200 shots in a ten minute workout.

(DAY OR OVERNIGHT/AGES 10-18)

3. Individual Camp - Each session of Individual Camp is designed to give players instruction in all phases of the game of basketball. Campers will be separated according to age and skill level. Campers participate in the same drills and receive the same instruction used with the Stetson University basketball program.

The camp will emphasize fundamentals in a way that makes learning the basics of basketball fun. Other features of the camp include 3 on 3 and 5 on 5 competition, a slam dunk contest for all campers, a 3 point shoot-out and a week ending tournament.

(DAY OR OVERNIGHT/AGES 8-18)

4. Little Hatter Camp - Each session of Little Hatter Camp is designed to give players an introduction to the fundamentals of basketball. The camp will emphasize fundamentals a way that makes learning the basics of basketball fun. This is a great way to jump start a young player's knowledge of the game. The Camp schedule will mirror our individual camp.

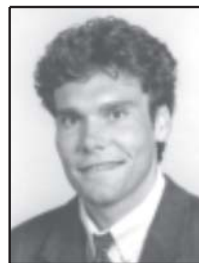

HEAD COACH DEREK WAUGH...

- is one of the youngest head coaches in Division I basketball and is the youngest head coach at Stetson since the legendary Glenn Wilkes.
- is third all time winningest coach in school history and the All-Time leader in conference wins.
- led Stetson to three school records for wins in the last three years.
- has helped produce 12 all-conference performers since his arrival at Stetson in 1997.
- has been organizing and running basketball camps for youths for eighteen years including running the largest camp in Atlanta, GA for eight years and the Stetson basketball camp for the last ten years.
- had a tremendous college basketball career at Furman University where he ranks as one of the school's top scorers, rebounders, and shooters. was named GTE Academic All-American in 1993.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

AGES: See the Camp descriptions. Players will be assigned to different groups and teams based on age and skill level.

SPECIAL FEATURES

- Individualized instruction (8 to 1 coach to camper ratio)
- 5 on 5 and 3 on 3 league play

STAFF: The staff will consist of the Stetson coaching staff, Stetson players and high school and college coaches.

COST: The fee for borders includes instruction, room and meals, a camp T-shirt, prizes, a written evaluation and insurance. The fee for day campers includes lunch and the above, with the exception of a room. **Shooting Camp – Overnight** \$260, **Day** \$210; **Position Camp – Overnight** \$375, **Day** \$285; **Individual Camp – Overnight** \$350, **Day** \$260; **Little Hatter Camps – Day** \$260 **Multiple Camp Packages – Shooting & Position Camp (2 camps) – Overnight** \$550, **Day** \$410 and **10% discount on any additional camp week.**

LOCATION: Stetson University is located in beautiful DeLand, Florida which is centrally located 20 miles west of Daytona Beach and 35 miles northeast of Orlando. Campers arriving from outside of Central Florida can make arrangements to be picked up at either airport by the camp staff. Both Orlando and Daytona Beach have major airports, and the DeLand Greyhound bus station is located within 1 mile of Stetson's campus.

FACILITIES: The camp is headquartered at the Edmunds Center on the campus of Stetson University. The Edmunds Center is a state of the art basketball facility and provides an excellent backdrop for the learning experience. The Hollis Center, located on campus, houses an outdoor pool and a state of the art game room.

Campers will be provided with quality living facilities located in very close proximity to the Edmunds Center. Excellent meals will be served on Stetson University's campus at the University Commons.
