# About Stetson University College of Law

Founded in 1900, Stetson University College of Law is Florida's first law school. With its main law campus in Gulfport and a satellite campus in Tampa, Stetson is fully accredited by the American Bar Association and has been a member of the Association of American Law Schools since 1931.

Stetson Law is ranked first in the nation for trial advocacy and fourth in legal writing. In addition to the juris doctor law degree, Stetson offers certificates of concentration in advocacy, elder law, environmental law, international law and social justice, dualdegree programs for the J.D./M.B.A., J.D./M.P.H., J.D./M.I.E.B.L. and J.D./M.I.N.T.E.C., Joint J.D./ LL.M. in Advocacy, and LL.M. degrees in advocacy, elder law and international law.

Stetson is home to the Centers for Excellence in Advocacy, Elder Law, Higher Education Law and Policy, and International Law, and Institutes for the Advancement of Legal Communication, Biodiversity Law, Caribbean Law, and Veterans Law. Stetson offers international programs in eight countries, including a semester program in London, England.

An international leader in advocacy education, Stetson has a long-standing record of championships at the world, national, regional and state levels of interscholastic competition. Students can further expand their practical experience by participating in clinical or internship opportunities.

Stetson University's DeLand campus is home to the College of Arts and Sciences, School of Business Administration, and School of Music. The Stetson University Center at Celebration offers graduate and professional development programs.

### The Symbols of Commencement

Academic Regalia: Academic disciplines are noted by color; law is represented as purple. The doctoral gown has bell sleeves with velvet chevrons on the sleeves and velvet on the panels. The hood is bound and edged with purple velvet and lined with green, the official color of Stetson University as the institution conferring the degree. The tam combines the symbolism of the book and that of a privileged guild. Students graduating with anticipated honors wear a gold tassel on the cap, and others wear a purple tassel denoting the discipline of law.

Students wearing purple cords are LL.M. graduates. Gold cords are worn by students graduating with anticipated honors. Student leaders and named award winners wear green cords. Students wearing blue cords have earned the William F. Blews Pro Bono Service Award. Students wearing red, white and blue cords are U.S. Military Veterans. The Mace: The Stetson University Mace, used during all commencement ceremonies, is a ceremonial staff used as a symbol of the right to confer degrees. The Stetson mace, designed by Episcopalian Canon Edward Nason West of the Cathedral Church of St. John the Divine, New York, was presented to President J. Ollie Edmunds in 1956.

The Medallion: The President's Medallion, worn at official academic occasions, was first used for the inauguration of President John E. Johns in 1969. The silver medallion includes the University Seal embraced by a wreath of laurel. The circular seal, adopted between 1889 and 1891, bears the motto *Pro Deo et Veritate* ("For God and Truth") and the Light of Truth resting on the Book of Wisdom.

# Honorary Degree Citation

#### RONALD L. BURGESS JR., you have distinguished yourself in service and leadership to your country.

You are a retired U.S. Army lieutenant general who dedicated a lifetime to leading national intelligence. You served 38 years in the U.S. Army. You directed the Defense Intelligence Agency and are the former acting principal deputy director of National Intelligence. You are presently serving Auburn University as senior counsel for national security programs, cyber programs and military affairs. Throughout your career, you have been recognized for your contributions to the U.S. national intelligence community. You continue to provide exceptional leadership and broad strategic vision that contributes to safeguarding U.S. national security interests.

You were commissioned in Military Intelligence through the Auburn University ROTC Program in 1974, earning a Master of Science degree in Education from the University of Southern California in 1980, and a Master of Military Arts and Science from the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College in 1986. Your military education includes the Armor Officer Basic Course, the Military Intelligence Officers Advanced Course, the Command and General Staff College, the Advanced Military Studies Program, and the Air War College.

As director of the Defense Intelligence Agency and acting principal deputy director of National Intelligence, you were a key player within the national security arena, called upon by the President, the Secretary of Defense, the Director of National Intelligence, the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, and Congressional leaders for your opinions, advice and expertise. Your exceptional leadership skills were used to focus the Defense Intelligence Agency on the greatest challenges confronting the United States.

You have received many honors for your service, including the Defense Distinguished Service Medal, the National Intelligence Distinguished Service Medal, the Defense Superior Service Medal, the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal, Joint Service Commendation Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, NATO Medal–former Republic of Yugoslavia, Parachutist Badge, Joint Chiefs of Staff Identification Badge and Army Staff Identification Badge. During your career you have been recognized with awards by the governments of Colombia and Bolivia, you were presented with the Order of the Star of Romania by the President of Romania, and you were inducted in the National Order of the Legion of Honor by the President of France.

You received the 2013 Lifetime Achievement Award from the Auburn University Alumni Association, were inducted into the United States Army Military Intelligence Hall of Fame in 2015, and were inducted into the Army ROTC National Hall of Fame in 2016.

In light of your many achievements, and under the authority vested in me by Stetson University's Board of Trustees, I proudly present you with the Honorary Doctor of Laws degree.
