



Dual-Degree Programs

A student must be in the top 75% of the class with which the student is ranked to be admitted into any dual-degree program, including the J.D./M.B.A., J.D./M.P.H., and J.D./M.D. programs. Once accepted into a dual-degree program, a student must remain in the top 75% of the class with which the student is ranked. A student in a dual-degree program who falls into the bottom 25% of the class with which the student is ranked will not be permitted to continue in the dual-degree program until the student's rank returns to the top 75% of the class with which the student is ranked.
