Miscellaneous Policies that Relate to the Skills or Clinical Education Area

Evidence is a required pre-requisite to all clinics. Professional Responsibility is a required pre-requisite to all "Certification Clinics." Trial Advocacy is a required prerequisite for the Prosecution and Public Defender Clinics.

Though a student may not take the same clinic twice, no cap or limit is placed on the total number of credit hours for clinic instruction that a student may accumulate.

A student may not clerk while enrolled in a clinic program. A clinic instructor is given the authority to waive this for a particular student where a review of the student's proposed clerking activities determines that such would not interfere or be in conflict with the required activities of the clinic nor violate Supreme Court Rule, Florida Statute, or the Code of Professional Responsibility.

No payment may be made to students enrolled in clinic programs except for reimbursement of expenses. Agencies are free to pay any reasonably and actually incurred expenses of students arising from required clinic activities.
