Lessons are one-on-one, individually taught in Presser Hall (music building) on all orchestral and band instruments, guitar, piano, voice, and harp. Cameron Huster offers individual harp lessons. The age requirement for voice lessons is 15 and older.

Rebecca began her career as a performer, dancing with the Orlando City Ballet and the Southern Ballet Theatre (now Orlando Ballet), where she was also an instructor. She has trained with many of the greats of the Kirov and Bolshoi ballet companies including Luba Gulyaeva, Margarita Zagurskaya, Mikhail Lavrovsky, Nona Jetstovskia, and others. Her students have been accepted into such prestigious programs as The Nutmeg Conservatory, Ballet Hispanico, Boston Ballet, Orlando Ballet, North Carolina School of the Arts, Walnut Hill, and the USA International Ballet Competition Summer Intensive. Rebecca, who is also a graduate of the American Musical and Dramatic Academy in New York City, studied acting under Broadway producer Marsha Milgram Dodge and is the Drama teacher at the International Community School in Winter Park, FL. Rebecca is currently teaching Movement classes for Stetson University's School of Music and is delighted to begin her third year as the Artistic Director of the Community School of Dance.

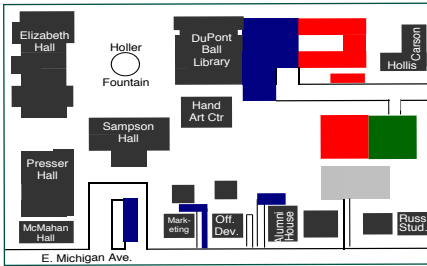
