**The Florida Flute Workshop** is open to students in grades 7-12 and focuses on building performance and musicianship skills. Students will learn through a combination of technique classes, master classes, flute choirs, small ensembles and private lessons and classes in rhythm, theory and music history. The Faculty will perform in an evening recital and guest artists will present clinics on various topics relating to the flute. The culmination of the Workshop will be the students' final concert for family and friends.

It should be emphasized that although there will be free-time activities, the focus is on learning, as this Workshop is an intensive educational and musical experience. Students should have progressed beyond a beginning level of instruction. Exceptional 6th graders may be considered for acceptance.
