

Hello from Stetson University! We are very excited you will be joining us for the 2017 Stetson University Flute Workshop. We are looking forward to a fun and educational week. Attached to this email you will find the following: directions to Stetson University, a “what to bring” list, rules and regulations, a tentative schedule for the week, and an “Informed Consent” form. All of these documents are also available for download from the camp website. Please read everything carefully. Some important items to note:

1. **Young Artist Recital auditions** will take place on the first day of camp. This audition is NOT required. If you choose to audition, you must email me the title of your solo prior to the camp.
2. Anyone wishing to audition on **piccolo** should prepare the flute audition excerpt on piccolo.
3. **The performance schedule is as follows. Family/friends may attend any of the concerts for free.**
 - a. **Tuesday, July 11th, 7:00 p.m. – Faculty Recital**
 - b. **Wednesday, July 12th, 7:30 p.m. – Student Counselor Recital**
 - c. **Thursday, July 13th, 7:30 p.m. – Young Artist Recital**
 - d. **Friday, July 14th, 7:30 p.m. – Chamber Groups recital**
 - e. **Saturday, July 15th, 2:30 p.m. – Final Concert**
4. **Final Concert dress** will be black skirt or pants (black socks and black shoes) with a white blouse or top for the ladies (NOT sleeveless); black dress pants (black socks and shoes) with a white shirt and appropriate tie for the gentlemen.
5. **If you would like to have the use of a locker during the week, please bring your own lock.**

Registration will be Monday, July 10, in Hatter Hall, beginning at 8:00 a.m. Registration will be staggered to allow better timing for auditions, so please watch your email the week prior to camp starting for your specific registration time. Placement auditions will be in Hatter Hall beginning at 9:00 a.m. Be prepared to play some scales in addition to the audition excerpt on the website.

The Flute Workshop is offering all interested participants, regardless of age, the opportunity to audition for the Young Artist Competition. Winners of this event will perform on the Young Artist Recital presented Thursday, July 13th, at 7:30 p.m. Stetson University will provide an accompanist for this performance; an accompanist is not required for the audition. Students planning to enter must email Dr. Phillips (tkphilli@stetson.edu) by July 5th with your name and the composer, title and movement (if applicable) of the piece you will be playing.

The solo of choice may not exceed 10 minutes.
