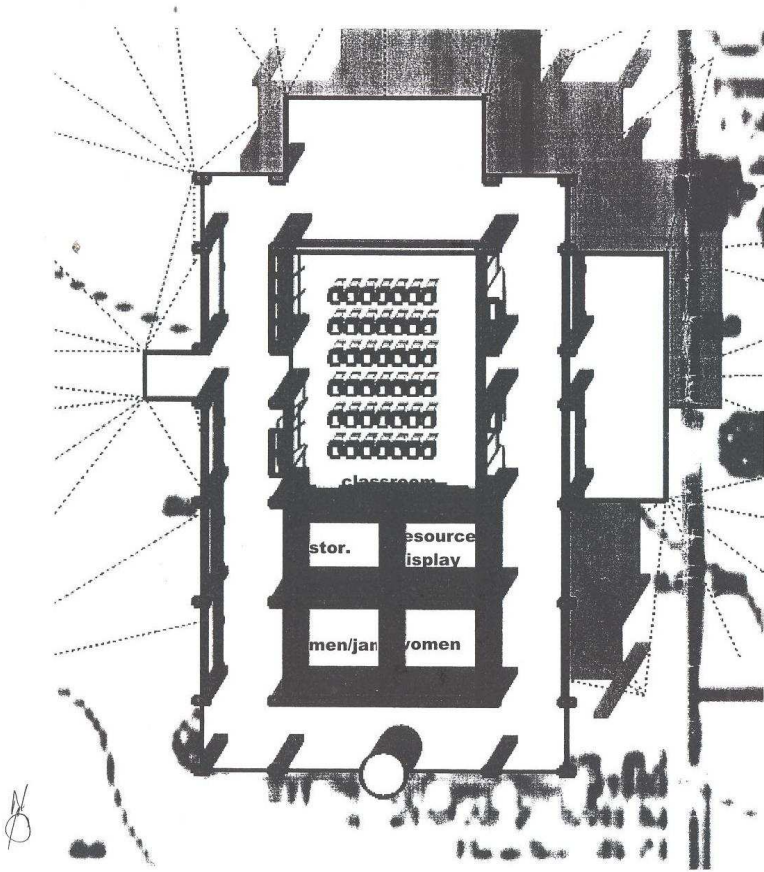
## DESIGN CONCEPT

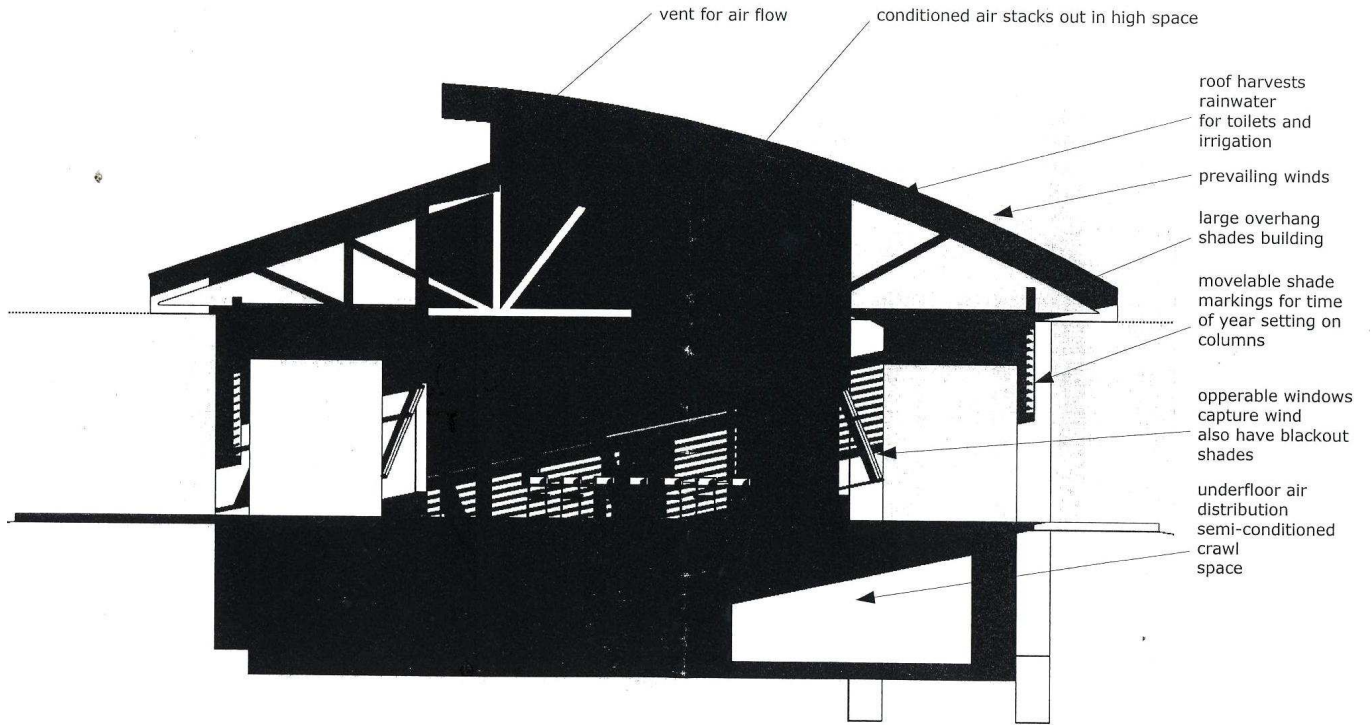

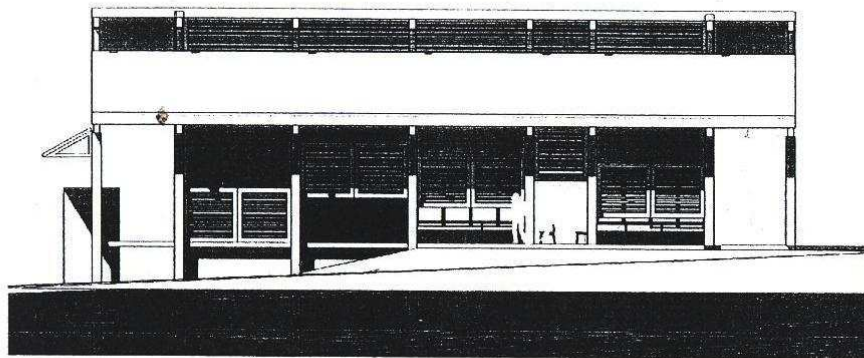

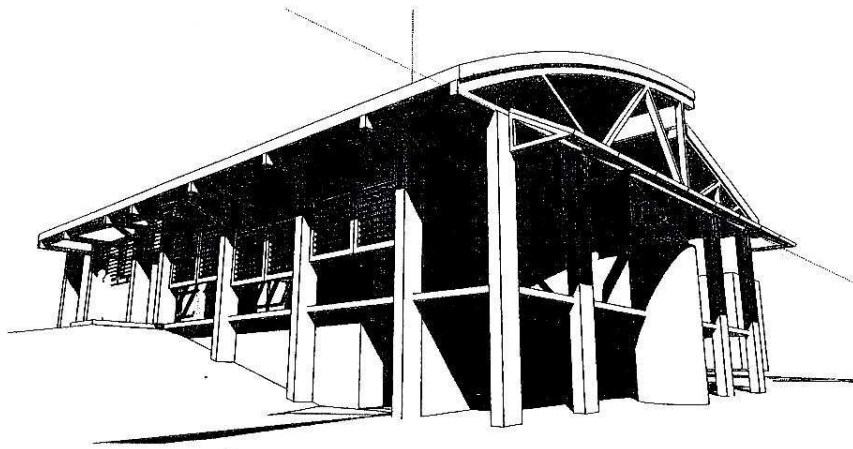
