Please attach:

1. A narrative description (not to exceed 1,500 words) of the goals and methodology of the proposed research project, including appropriate references, and written in accordance with the canons of the student's academic discipline. The narrative must minimally address; the purpose of the proposed research, the methods and procedures for achievement of the objectives, and the form and dissemination of the research results. For those requesting research-related funds, an additional budget sheet should outline both the amounts and purpose of those funds (e.g. travel, equipment, photocopying), up to and not to exceed \$500.
2. A 100-200 word abstract of your project, including your title, your name and your advisor's name. This abstract should summarize your project's essential content. It should be written so as to be understandable to a non-specialist in your field. For examples of abstracts, see the Stetson University Research and Creative Arts Symposium (formerly known as Undergraduate Scholarship Day or USD) web site at <http://www.stetson.edu/other/research/surcas>. Please attach a printed version of this abstract that should be included with all application materials; please also provide an electronic version of your abstract which should be e-mailed as an attachment to Dr. Kimberly Reiter, Chair of the Undergraduate Research Committee, c/o Jennifer Snyder at jsnyder1@stetson.edu when you submit your paper application. All abstracts should be in Word format and scanned for viruses prior to submission. Make sure that the electronic version of your abstract includes your name so that we can match it up with your paper application.
3. A copy of the student's Stetson academic transcript (available from the registrar).
