Directions to Patricia Wilson Field

(Signs will be posted on campus to direct you.)

From Orlando: Take I-4 east to Exit 118, State Road 44, turn right onto 44. Travel approximately 5 miles into DeLand, take a right onto Amelia. Make a right onto Arizona, it will be about ½ mile down and your 6th right, the **field** is down the block on your right.

From Jacksonville: I-95 South to Route 92 (Exit 261), west approximately 20 miles. Turn left onto Amelia at the 7-11 (Just past the Holiday Inn on your left) Take Amelia approximately 1 mile. Turn left after the crosswalk light onto Arizona, the **field** is at the end of the block on your right

From Miami: I-95 North to State Road 44 (DeLand/New Smyrna Beach Exit). Go west approximately 23 miles to DeLand. Take a right on Amelia Avenue (Sun Trust Bank is on the left corner), make a right on Arizona (it is ½ mile down and your 6th right), the field is at the end of the block on your right.

From I-75 (in Ocala): Take Ocala Exit 69 (State Road 40) east to US Highway 17 into Barberville (approximately 45 miles). Turn right (south) onto Highway 17 and travel 14 miles to the SU campus. Turn left onto Pennsylvania, take that through campus and turn right at the first light, Amelia Avenue. Take Amelia past one crosswalk light and turn left on Arizona (about 1 mile from Pennsylvania), the **field** is at the end of the block on your right.
