Credit will be allowed for those courses in which the student has earned a grade of “C” (not C-) or better and which are equivalent to courses offered at Stetson University. A course completed elsewhere at the lower division (100 or 200) level that is taught at Stetson at the upper-division level may not normally be used to satisfy a junior or senior-level (300 or 400) requirement even if the title of the course is the same or seems similar.

Once 60 hours of credit have been earned in courses generally accepted in a Bachelor’s degree program, no additional credit may be transferred from a lower division, 2-year community, or junior college. Students may not receive credit for more than 9 hours in the summer without advanced approval of the academic dean. Students must complete their last year of academic work (usually 30 hours) at Stetson University.
