

Billing Information

Payment Deadline: Review your invoice for errors and/or omissions and remit payment in full by the required due date, **July 15, 2026**. **Classes will be cancelled for prior semester balances of \$500 or more on August 14, 2026.**

Monthly Payment Plan (MPP): Stetson University offers a monthly payment plan with up to **five payments per semester**. **You must sign up for the MPP at the beginning of each semester.** The number of payments is based on the date your requested plan is approved and established. Fall semester payments begin on July 15th to take advantage of the full five payments. Spring semester payments begin December 15th for the full five payments. Prior semester balances must be paid-in-full to be eligible to continue the MPP. Please visit the Methods of Payment page on the Bursar's website for more information and sign up for an MPP:

Payment types: Stetson University accepts the following forms of payment in our office: personal and bank checks, cash, and money orders. **All credit or debit card payments must be made online and are subject to a 2.55% convenience fee.** We accept e-check payments online via your myStetson Portal or our website:

Additional Charges/Credits: New charges or credits posted to the students' account will be billed monthly and will be due upon receipt of the bill on which the charges appear. If you are on a Monthly Payment Plan (MPP), the new charges/credits posted to the account will be incorporated into the next monthly billing statement and any amount above the established monthly amount due for your MPP will be due by the due date on the statement. The established monthly amount due for your MPP will not be adjusted for the remaining months on your plan.

Financial Aid: If the financial aid award on your billing statement differs from your award letter, you may view your financial aid award(s) in the Financial Aid Dashboard on your myStetson Portal or contact the Office of Financial Planning at 386-822-7120 for assistance. Please ensure that all documents have been completed prior to your arrival on campus to avoid any delays.

Consent to Release Records: *The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA)*, as amended, is a federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. Students must establish Authorized User(s) to grant permission for university personnel to release some or all their educational records to any individual(s) other than the student themselves. You may access the Authorized User link by going to your myStetson Portal and clicking on the Authorized User tile. An Authorized User Guide is provided to help you set up your Authorized User(s).

Course Registration/Enrollment Eligibility: Eligibility for course registration and enrollment will be dependent upon payment of student account balances. You must either pay your account balance in full or establish a Monthly Payment Plan (MPP) to register for and remain enrolled in your courses. **Course registration will be cancelled for prior semester balances of \$500 or more on August 14, 2026.**
