Frequently Asked Questions

Who can apply for the Impact Fund? Current undergraduate students enrolled at Stetson University.

How much funding is available? It depends on the total amount of alumni and organizational donations and may vary from year to year.

When should I apply? The Internship Impact Fund Application is typically open during the month of March. Please plan to complete your application during that window.

Can I complete a paid internship and still receive an award? Yes, however, preference will be given to students completing unpaid internships.

Do I have to be pursuing a specific major/program of study to be eligible? No – we strongly encourage students from all majors to apply.

How will I find out if I received an award? All applicants will be notified of their application status via the e-mail address provided with the application by mid-April. Please submit an email address you check often.

Will I receive the award prior to my departure? Students will receive 80% of their award before leaving campus at the end of the Spring semester. The remaining 20% will be awarded after the student completes the additional program requirements.

What do I need to do after receiving the award? Each Impact Fund recipient is required to complete the following:

- Attend an Internship Impact Fund Introductory Meeting
- Write a thank you note to your alumni donor or organization
- Provide receipts to show how the funds were used
- Complete an online portfolio (video, Prezi, etc.) outlining your experience
