What is CPT?

Curricular Practical Training (CPT) is temporary authorization for international students studying on an F-1 Visa to participate in paid or unpaid practical training, such as an internship, directly related to your major field of study.”

Bachelors in
Applied Mathematics - Actuarial and Financial Mathematics
DO NOT qualify for CPT

Stetson Requirements

- 1: You must have a declared Major
- 2: You must take the academic internship course during the internship
- 3: The academic internship course must apply towards your major

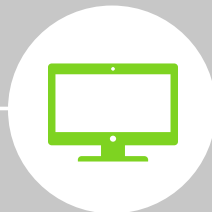
*If you do not meet the requirements above then you **CANNOT** participate in an internship in the United States

These are the steps



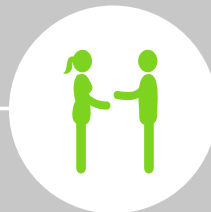
#1

Make sure you meet all Stetson CPT requirements (listed above)



#2

Make an appointment with Career & Professional Development to discuss internships



#3

Meet with your Faculty Adviser to make sure Requirement 3 (listed above) will appear on your Degree Audit

Find an internship and register for the academic internship course
