What is CPT?

Curricular Practical Training (CPT) is temporary authorization for international students studying on an F-1 Visa to participate in paid or unpaid practical training, such as an internship, directly related to your major field of study.

Stetson Requirements

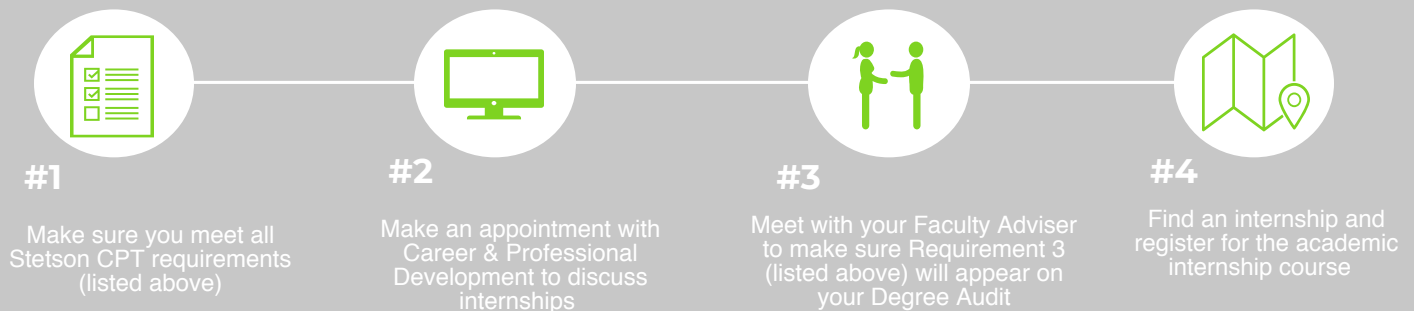
- 1: You must have a declared Major
- 2: You must take the academic internship course during the internship
- 3: The academic internship course must count as a MAJOR Elective or must fulfill the Experiential Learning Requirement (ELR) as shown on your official Degree Audit

*If you do not meet the requirements above then you **CANNOT** participate in an internship in the United States

If you answered NO continue to question two

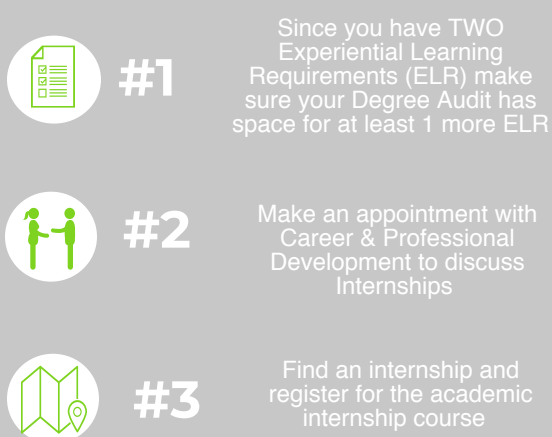

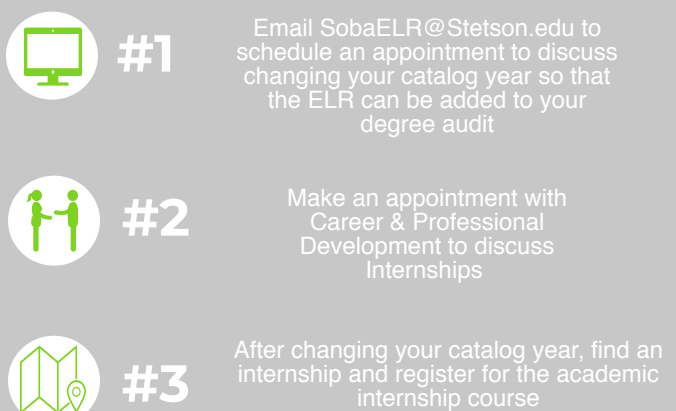
Question Two: Did you start at Stetson in Fall 2017 or later?
