

# The Cici & Hyatt Brown Hall for Health & Innovation

This 40,000-square-foot building connects to Sage Hall Science Center, creating a 120,000-square-foot science complex and allowing Stetson to expand its health and science programs at a time when student interest in these programs has skyrocketed.

### **Timeline**

**April 9, 2018:** University Trustees <u>Cici and Hyatt Brown donate \$18 million</u>, the largest single gift in university history, to construct a new science building and expand science programs.

June 11, 2021: <u>The University breaks ground</u> on the Cici & Hyatt Brown Hall For Health & Innovation. It will connect to Sage Hall Science Center, recently renovated with new labs and other upgrades.

**Oct. 28, 2022:** The University cuts the ribbon on the new \$19 million Cici & Hyatt Brown Hall for Health & Innovation. Students, faculty and staff will begin using the building in January 2023.
