

Help us rebuild Hulley Tower

Originally constructed in 1934, Hulley Tower is now a shell of its former self after being battered by multiple hurricanes in 2004 and taken down to its base a year later. In 2023, we launched an historic reconstruction effort to restore Hulley Tower to its former 116-foot height with a new 52-bell carillon at the top to ring out across campus. The former Eloise chimes will be incorporated into the reconstruction in other ways, paying homage to Hulley Tower's place in our history.
