



Campus Master Plan Progress Update




The campus planning team from Page is currently in phase 3 of a five-phase process. To date, Page has completed existing condition analysis, preliminary assessments, space verification, and preliminary needs identification for the DeLand and Gulfport campuses. The team has participated in ten focus group discussions and multiple one-on-one listening sessions with key leadership, which have directly informed the planning themes and initial concepts that the campus master plan is organized around defined below.

In early February, the Steering Committee and Working Group convened to preview the preliminary space needs outcomes, planning themes, and initial concepts for the DeLand and Gulfport campuses. The feedback and key takeaways from those discussions will inform the team's next steps as they finalize the space needs outcomes, refine the planning concepts, and develop the draft plan.

Space and Facility Optimization


- Promote department distribution and space efficiencies that foster learning and collaboration.
