3	Jnited States Travel Document. This document has a mint green cover. This replaces the Reentry Permit (Form I- 327) and the Refugee Travel Document (Form I-571). It is used by lawful permanent residents, refugees, and asylees and must be annotated: "Permit to Reenter Form I-327".
u 5	Machine Readable Immigrant Visa. The MRIV will appear in the holder's (foreign) passport. If the passport is unexpired and endorsed with an admission stamp and the statement "Upon endorsement serves as temporary I-551 evidencing permanent residence for 1 year," it serves as a temporary I-551 and as valid documentation for establishing aid eligibility.
