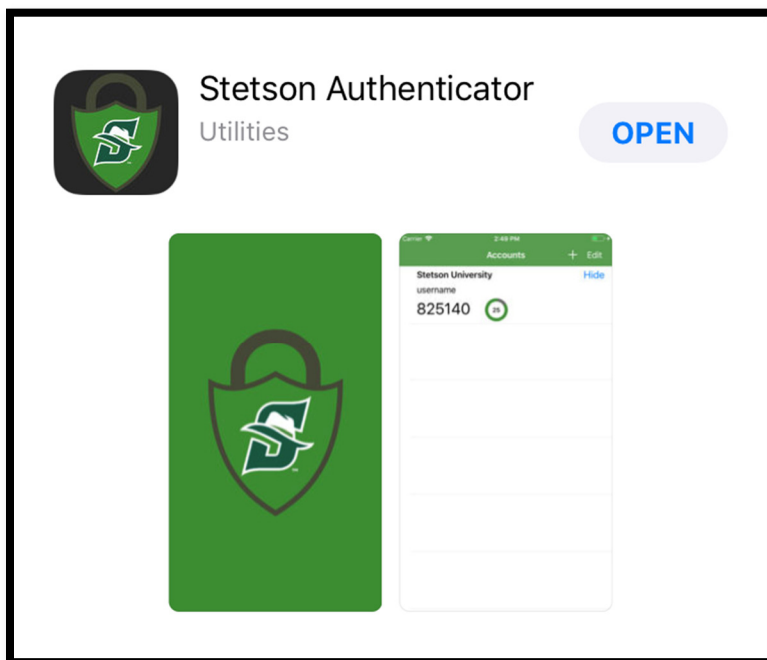


When you log in to my.stetson.edu, you will see this page and will be prompted to install the Stetson Multi-factor Authenticator app.



Go to the App Store or Google Play to download the Stetson Authenticator app.

Stetson Multi-factor Authentication
Install Stetson Authenticator for iOS/Android



1. Launch the (iOS) App Store or (Android) Google Play Store and search for "Stetson Authenticator".
2. Tap "Get" and then "Install" to download the app.

When prompted, make sure to allow notifications and access to the camera in order to use push authentication and be able to scan the QR code

If you are viewing this page on your mobile device, tap the QR code to launch the app and register. Otherwise, proceed with the following steps

3. Open Stetson Authenticator.
4. Tap the "+" button.
5. Scan the QR code.


