



The data reports page provides links to several different Stetson University–specific reports and publications. This page has its own unique left-side menu:






## Enrollment and Census Reports

1. One of the most visited pages on the IRE website, the enrollment and census reports page displays the most current enrollment snapshot data, along with links to enrollment summary and infographic PDFs.



- 2. The University Enrollment Summary is an excellent resource for key census data points, including breakdowns by:
  - Undergraduate/Graduate level
  - Campus
  - Academic Unit
  - Gender
  - Class Standing
  - IPEDS Race/Ethnicity
  - FTIC
  - Transfer


This summary also shares updated retention rates for FTIC, Transfer and Law Students, and graduation rates for 4-year and 6-year FTIC cohorts and 3-year Law School cohorts.





- 1. The Enrollment and Census reports page also features two Power BI enrollment dashboards:
  - a. DeLand Enrollment
  - b. College of Law Enrollment
- 2. Power BI dashboards are interactive data displays that allow users to filter the data based on selected fields.
- 3. Users can "pop-out" the dashboards into full-screen mode by clicking the arrow in the lower right hand corner of the dashboard:

# **DeLand Enrollment**




(Note: The Power BI dashboards are a snapshot of university data as of the census date, not a live pull of current data)


3. Users can find archived enrollment summaries and infographics at the bottom of the page.






## Just The Facts

Moving on to the second item in the data reports section, **Just the Facts** is an annual infographic brochure with current data about the university's faculty and student population.








### Fact Book




### Retention & Graduation Outcomes

  - g. Retention and Graduation Rates of FTIC Students by Financial Aid Status






- 2. Users can pop-out the Power BI dashboard to full-screen mode by clicking on the arrow in the lower-righthand corner

### Common Data Set

NOTE – Nonresidents are to be reported separately, in the boxes provided, rather than included in any of the seven racial/ethnic categories or in race/ethnicity unknown.


NOTE – Norresidents are to be reported separately in the boxes provided, rather than included in any of the seven racial ethnic categories or in race/ethnicity unknown. Dual Errollment: If your institution errolls high school students in college courses for credit either within a dual enrollment program or outside of a dual enrollment program, you may report the unduplicated count as part of the non-degree-seeking students included in the "Total Undergraduates footh degree & non-fegree-seeking) section.
