University General Education Committee

Continuing Education and Lifelong Learning Committee

### Membership

- Four faculty (representing each College/School, appointed by Provost, in consultation with Deans, Faculty Senate Chair, and Director of Continuing Education);
- Chair, Academic Technology Committee;
- Staff representative from University Alumni Affairs (appointed by Provost, in consultation with Vice President for Development);
- Two community members-at-large (invited by Provost, in consultation with Vice President for Development and Director of Continuing Education, and others);
- Director, Continuing Education (ex officio, non-voting);
- Associate Vice President, Celebration Center (ex officio, non-voting); and
- Registrar or designee (ex officio, non-voting).

# Curriculum Proposals – Continuing Education and Lifelong Learning

The University Continuing Education Committee is charged with defining guiding criteria for reviewing and recommending certificate and other continuing education programs offered by units based at the DeLand and Celebration campuses. UCCAP will review the proposed review criteria, and make a recommendation to the Provost for approval. The University Continuing Education Committee will then apply the approved criteria to certificate and other continuing education programs and make recommendations to UCCAP. UCCAP will review and consent to the recommendations, confirming that there has been sufficient consideration of and planning for resource and program implications for the home program/department and other University departments (e.g., other Colleges/Schools, Library, Academic

Technology, Facilities), and forward recommendations to the Provost for approval. The Provost will forward approved programs to the University Registrar for official recording.
