

Proposal 3: Changes to the Steering Committee

2010 Defining Document Language

1. The Provost and Deans are primarily responsible for supporting the academic enterprise and advancing institutional priorities. To facilitate the effective and efficient movement from review, to recommendation, to action on curriculum and academic policy enhancements, a UCCAP Steering Group including the chair of UCCAP, the chair of the University General Education Committee, and the Faculty Senate UCCAP representative will meet regularly with the Provost and Deans of the College of Arts and Sciences, School of Business Administration, and School of Music—and when relevant the Vice President and Dean of the College of Law—to discuss and guide current proposals through the review and recommendation process.
2. Academic policy proposals will be submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs and initially considered by the UCCAP Steering Group (chair of UCCAP, the chair of the University General Education Committee, the Faculty Senate UCCAP representative, Provost, Deans). The UCCAP Steering Group may clarify the policy proposal, as needed, and may articulate the parameters within which the proposed policy may be feasible.

2021 Proposed Substantive Changes

Replace the Sections above with, respectively:

1. UCCAP Advisory Group: The Provost and Deans are primarily responsible for supporting the academic enterprise and advancing institutional priorities. For guidance on major curricular and academic policy issues, a UCCAP Advisory Group will meet at least once a semester. To facilitate the effective and efficient movement from review, to recommendation, to action on curriculum and academic policy enhancements, UCCAP Advisory Group members include:
 - chair of UCCAP
 - chair of the UGEC
 - Faculty Senate UCCAP representative
 - Provost
 - Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences
 - Dean of the School of Business Administration
 - Dean of the School of Music
 - University Registrar, when necessary for the discussion

- Dean of the College of Law, when relevant
- Dean of the Library, when relevant

2. Academic policy proposals will be submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs and initially considered by the UCCAP Advisory Group. The UCCAP Advisory Group may clarify the policy proposal, as needed, and may articulate the parameters within which the proposed policy may be feasible.
