UCCAP's Work

- ▶ Revision of Defining Document over past 3 years
- ▶ Defining Document from UCCAP – January 2021
- ▶ Defining Document from Faculty Senate – February 2021
- ▶ Summary of Revisions from UCCAP and Faculty Senate

Faculty Senate's Work

- ▶ Brought concerns to faculty in Fall 2020
- ▶ Linked with work on representation
- ▶ Waited for UCCAP's revisions, received in January 2021
- ▶ Reviewed and revised those, brought proposals to Senate in February
- ▶ Discussion and voting on some proposals in March
- ▶ Additional discussion and voting in April
- ▶ Goal: complete revisions this year

First Proposal

Eliminate the Continuing Education and Lifelong Learning Committee

- ▶ Committee is non-active

Second Proposal

Change UCCAP Steering Group to UCCAP Advisory Group and require meetings at least once per semester.

- ▶ UCCAP Steering has not been active
- ▶ This is an attempt to fix it

Third Proposal

Eliminate the Academic Planning Advisory Committee

- ▶ Committee is non-active

Fourth Proposal

Change Administrative Oversight of UGEC

- ▶ Moving oversight from Dean of CAS to Provost since Gen-ed is university-wide

Fifth Proposal

Replacing Workflows in the Defining Document

- ▶ Replace 2010 charts with updated workflows
- ▶ Workflows will follow the DD and be reviewed by the Senate

What else is coming?

Proposed changes to membership (still under discussion in Senate)

▶ UCCAP:

- ▶ Replace one A&S rep with four divisional A&S reps
 - ▶ Current TT Faculty: 128 in CAS, 33 in SoBA, 21 in SoM and 6 in Library
- ▶ Make library rep a full voting member
 - ▶ Argument: the library is relevant for all curriculum
- ▶ Add two graduate reps
 - ▶ Graduate curriculum committees asked for reps. Stetson does not separate Graduate Faculty
- ▶ Change eligibility so contingent faculty may serve
 - ▶ Motivation is to allow PoPs to serve, but without a robust termination policy that is against AAUP guidelines

▶ UGEC:

- ▶ Make library rep a full voting member
