### DIVERSITY IN THE STUDENT BODY: ADMISSIONS COMMITTEE, FACULTY FINANCE COMMITTEE, SENATE EXEC

- SAT requirements
  - Waived for 2020-2021
  - Should that become permanent?
  - Should we consider diversity scholarships?
- Retention and Graduation differences by race
  - Differences in descriptive data need further investigation.
    - Retention: Senate will continue work on modeling retention in depth
    - Graduation: similar modeling/analysis could be done in collaboration with IRE
- Mentoring of diverse Students
  - Linked with conversations about hiring, advising and advising loads

# DIVERSITY AMONG FACULTY: FACULTY WELFARE COMMITTEE

- Hiring
  - Approval of lines/allocation of resources
  - Training of search committees
- Compensation
  - Senate conversation is underway; data is needed regularly for comparison both with peer institutions and within Stetson.
- Evaluation
  - SET task force is analyzing data; report expected this year
- Mentoring
  - FWC and Brown Center
- Support for Faculty
  - Childcare, Leave policy, summer compensation, Senate meeting time/common hour

#### DIVERSITY IN REPRESENTATION: COMMITTEE ON COMMITTEES

- Elected bodies: Faculty Senate, UCCAP, Curriculum Committees
  - Faculty: know your reps and hold us accountable
  - CoC and Senate Exec will encourage nominations and campaigning for Senate seats in spring
- University committees
  - Current list of committees is on Academic Affairs website.
    - CoC will be polling faculty this spring earlier and in more detail!
  - How do we make them more representative while protecting service loads?
- Board of Trustees
  - Senate Exec and Chair are working with President Roellke, will link several faculty reps with board committees starting in January
- Communication and Feedback
  - Faculty Satisfaction survey: results soon!
    - Quantitative in November
    - Qualitative in January/February need some expertise!
