Stetson University Fall 2023 New Student Check-In FAQ

What is New Student Check-In?

• New Student Check-In is the process in which you are officially checked into campus and FOCUS.

All new students will check-in on Saturday, August 13 from 8 a.m. – 2 pm. In the Lynn Business Center Parking Lot. If you have not scheduled an <u>arrival appointment</u> please ensure you do so. Students who are already moved onto campus for athletics or other events do NOT need to schedule an arrival appointment.

- During New Student Check-In you will receive important information needed for orientation and to start the semester. This includes:
 - o Residence hall key if you are living on campus
 - Stetson ID card
 - o FOCUS Orientation name tag and other important orientation information
 - New Hatter Swag!

Where should I go for New Student Check-in?

All incoming students will check in at the Lynn Business Center parking lot on Saturday, August 19 from 8

 a.m. – 2 p.m. An <u>appointment</u> must be made for residential New Student Check-In.

How do I sign up for a New Student Check-In appointment?

What should I bring to New Student Check-In?

• You should bring a government issued ID, your Stetson ID number and student ID (if you have it already).

I did not attend Summer Orientation. Is there anything special I should do on check-in day?

• Students who did not attend summer orientation are required to attend a make-up session at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 19 in the Edmunds Center. Please ensure you schedule a check-in appointment early enough in the day to attend this session. If you are a residential student, we highly encourage you give yourself plenty of time to unload all your items into your residence hall.

How should I plan to enter the check-in line at the Lynn Business Center parking lot? Are there specific directions we should be following?

• Approaching from Orlando-

- Option 1 Exit Interstate 4, taking US 472 west. Merge north onto Woodland Blvd. Turn right on Wisconsin Ave. and proceed east. Turn Left onto Hayden Ave and you will be in the line for checkin.
- Option 2 Exit Interstate 4, taking State Road 44 west. Turn right onto Amelia Ave and proceed north. Turn left on Wisconsin Ave. and proceed west. Then Right onto Hayden Ave and you will be in the line for check-in.
- Approaching from Daytona Beach
 - Exit Interstate 95, taking US 92 west. Turn left and proceed south on Woodland Blvd. Turn left on Wisconsin Ave. and proceed east. Then Left onto Hayden Ave and you will be in the line for checkin.
- <u>Approaching from the North/ Northwest</u>
 - Take US 17 south, which becomes Woodland Blvd. Turn left on Wisconsin Ave. and proceed east. Then Left onto Hayden Ave and you will be in the line for check-in.
- Approaching from the West
 - Take State Road 44 east. Turn left onto Amelia Ave and proceed north. Turn left on Wisconsin Ave. and proceed west. Then Right onto Hayden Ave and you will be in the line for check-in.

What happens if there is severe weather during Residential New Student Check-in?

• Severe weather is always a concern in Central Florida. While we will continue to serve vehicles in rainy conditions, extra precautions will be taken for more severe conditions. In the event of high winds or lightning in the area, our check-in process must shut down for at least approximately 30 minutes or longer depending on the duration of the severe weather to ensure the safety of our check-in staff. Please plan to shelter in place in your vehicle if this situation does occur.

I am a residential student. Where should I go after we finish at the Lynn Business Center?

During move-in, Stetson University creates specific traffic flow patterns for students and guests to follow to
ensure everyone has a smooth move-in experience. We encourage you to review the <u>Move-In Traffic Flow</u>
<u>Map</u> prior to arrival so you are familiar with where to go after check-in.

Will there be any assistance provided to help me get my things into my residence hall room?

• Home Team, a group of current students who are excited to help and welcome you to campus, will be available to assist with your move-in. If you plan to use Home Team assistance, we highly suggest marking your belongings with your name and room number before heading to campus.

I am already on campus for a student organization or sports team. How do I get my FOCUS materials?

• Please visit the Lynn Business Center Lobby from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. on Saturday, August 19. Your FOCUS materials will be ready for you to pick up during this time.
