Student Development & Campus Vibrancy offers services that assist students with Student Development and Leadership Opportunities; Student Organization Engagement; Student Media Services; Fraternity & Sorority Involvement; First Year and Experience and Transitions and campus activities that keep the student experience vibrant and engaging.

Wellness and Recreation offers programs and services, educating and empowering the community to lead healthy lives. Hollis Center operations, sport programs, fitness incentives, group exercise, and overall wellness information may be provided from this department.

Financial Aid offers services that assists students and their families with information on ways to pay for their education.

Bursar offers services with ensuring that students' tuition and fee payments are received and processed.

Career and Professional Development offers career, major, and graduate school exploration/decision-making, resume and cover letter assistance, interview training and practice, and internship and job search help.

Academic Success provides opportunities for students to reach their individual educational goals by providing equal access and skills based coaching and tutoring.

Office of Diversity & Inclusion supports students and student groups by encouraging inclusivity, offering training and workshops that further inclusive excellence and cultural awareness, and building a community environment that is increasingly aware of diverse social identities.

Registrar assists students by maintaining accurate and confidential records regarding a student's academic performance. The registrar also provides students with services that allow for withdrawal or enrollment of courses, providance of transcript requests, and credit and transcript review.

Center of Community Engagement provides opportunities for student learning through community impact. The CCE connects students with volunteer opportunities and internships with local non-profit and government agencies.

Religious and Spiritual Life empowers students to lead lives of meaning. This office connects students to Stetson's vibrant religious student organizations, provides resources on religious literacy and spiritual wellness, and offers support to process life events.

Title IX assists students by responding to reported acts of sex-based discrimination by coordinating investigations, providing supportive services, addressing patterns of sex-based discrimination, and educating the campus community on related issues.

Dean of Students Office provides support and advocacy to students. This office also leads crisis support and provides follow up care through HattersCare for students in need.
