N = 452 likely voters | credibility interval +/- 5%

The survey collected data via an online non-probability sample from Qualtrics's panels. The data was weighted to reflect the 2024 General Election Likely Voter population. Weighted variables include DMA grouping, gender, age, political party, race, ethnicity, and education. Estimates for all demographics were sourced from records based on voter turnout in Florida in previous elections and were adjusted for a likely voter audience based on
