Purpose

The Faculty Research and Professional Growth grant program provides funding to support the meritorious scholarly or creative work of full-time Stetson faculty members.

Funding Cycles and Application Deadlines

Fall 26 Application Cycle

Project Period: January through May (2027)

Application Deadline: November 1, 2026

Post-Project Report Deadline: August 30, 2027

Spring 27 Application Cycle

Project Period: May through December (2027)

Application Deadline: March 1, 2027

Post-Project Report Deadline: December 10, 2027

Submission Instructions

Prior to starting this application please review all information, guidelines and requirements in the Faculty Research and Professional Growth (FRPG) Guidelines, Application Process and Evaluation Criteria document. Please also consult the Faculty Research and Professional Growth FAQ.

Applications should be constructed as a single PDF file, saved as “FACULTYLASTNAME_FRPGAPP”

Applications should be submitted, by the deadlines above, using the [online submission form](#). In that form, you will need to upload your completed PDF application, which should contain the information requested below.

Application

1. State the nature and purpose of your project in terms intelligible to a non-specialist. If the current project is related to a long-term plan of research, review your anticipated completion schedule. (Max 400 words).
2. In what ways will the proposed funding contribute to your broader research agenda? What are the ultimate plans to publish or otherwise use the results of this project? (Max 250 words).
3. Outline how the research project may contribute (directly or indirectly) to the expansion or enhancement of student engaged learning opportunities. (Max 250 words).
4. Provide a comprehensive line-item budget that includes all expenses associated with the project. (Note: All expenses should be included in this budget, even if funds are not requested for all items. Please be sure to distinguish which items are being requested for FRPG funding.)
5. Specify what role an FRPG grant would play in the total budget for your project, what minimum amount is necessary for the project to be initiated or proceed, and in what ways an FRPG grant might lead to additional funds from other sources (if applicable).
6. What other sources have you considered that may support, now or in the future, this research? Have you requested support from any such source?
7. List the financial support that you have received from RPG grants during the past three years. Itemize and define how these grants were utilized.

As part of the online submission, please include a two-page vita that highlights scholarly and professional activity over the most recent five years.
