## Experiential Learning Requirement Approval Criteria

Criterion	Below Expectations (0)	Meets Expectations (1)
<b>Education &amp; Career Alignment</b>	The experience does not align with the student's course of study and/or career path.	The experience functions and expectations align with the student's course of study and/or career path. The experience is an extension of the curriculum: a learning experience that provides for applying the knowledge gained through the curriculum.
<b>Length of Experience</b>	The experience does not have a clear start or end date. The experience is less than 6 weeks in length.	The experience has a clear schedule that allows for the student to complete a minimum of 70 hours in the course of 6 weeks.
<b>Learning Objectives/Goals</b>	The student expressed vague or superficial learning objectives/goals. The objectives/goals are not related to the student's professional goals. The objectives/goals are mainly administrative.	There are clearly developed learning objectives/goals related to the professional goals of the student's academic coursework. Student will be introduced to ongoing organizational projects or will be guided developing new projects useful to the organizations.
<b>Feedback, Supervision and Guidance</b>	The student will not have a supervisor who can provide specific training or guidance on the student's role/position. The supervisor will not be able to provide regular onsite feedback on the student's progress towards to objectives/goals.	There will be regular feedback by the intern's on-site supervisor. It is clear that there will be supervision, guidance, and feedback to student throughout his/her learning.
<b>Host Site and Working Environment</b>	The host site does not have an environment that supports the learning objectives/goals.	There are resources, equipment, and facilities provided by the host site that supports learning.
<b>Student's Role</b>	The student does not have an active role in the experience.	Students must have an active role in their internship and the organization.
