Length of Experience	The experience does not have a clear start or end date. The experience is less than 6 weeks in length.	The experience has a clear schedule that allows for the student to complete a minimum of 70 hours in the course of 6 weeks.
Learning Objectives/Goals	The student expressed vague or superficial learning objectives/goals. The objectives/goals are not related to the student's professional goals. The objectives/goals are mainly administrative.	There are clearly developed learning objectives/goals related to the professional goals of the student's academic coursework. Student will be introduced to ongoing organizational projects or will be guided developing new projects useful to the organizations.
Feedback, Supervision and Guidance	The student will not have a supervisor who can provide specific training or guidance on the student's role/position. The supervisor will not be able to provide regular onsite feedback on the student's progress towards to objectives/goals.	There will be regular feedback by the intern's on-site supervisor. It is clear that there will be supervision, guidance, and feedback to student throughout his/her learning.
Host Site and Working Environment	The host site does not have an environment that supports the learning objectives/goals.	There are resources, equipment, and facilities provided by the host site that supports learning.
Student's Role	The student does not have an active role in the experience.	Students must have an active role in their internship and the organization.
