25 26 27 28	A:	I don't remember the date. I was pretty tired from being at a concert the night before.
29 30	Q:	Wasn't Nellie there the same day the process server came by?
31 32	A:	Yeah, so what?
33 34	Q:	Is that a yes?
35 36	A:	Yes. But s/he [Nellie] left around noon that day.
37 38 39	Q:	Why didn't you tell the process server that your mother/father [Nellie] had just left?
40 41	A:	Don't know. I didn't think about it.
41 42 43	Q:	What time did Nellie leave?
44 45	A:	Probably around noon.

1 2 3	Q:	Tell me about the phone call between your mother and father, the one you told the process server about.
4 5 6 7 8 9 10	A:	I remember leaving the house early the Saturday before I guess it was November 1, 2014, I was working on my mother's/father's [Nellie] computer. It had been "broken" for months s/he was always bring it me for me to fix. Anyway, my father/mother stopped me on my way out the door and told me that s/he just received a phone call from mom/dad [Nellie]. S/he said that s/he [Nellie] seemed particularly nervous about some lawsuit because of her report that s/he wrote about the over armor scandal.

14 15 16 17 18 19	A:	I don't know exactly, s/he [Nellie] always uses these weird quotes from movies, particularly that old Southern film, "Gone with the Wind." Something about "they'll never find her/him." I don't remember exactly what it was.

22 23	A:	I assume she meant Over-Armor
24 25	Q:	Did you ever talk to your mother/father [Nellie] about that?
26 27	A:	Yeah, I spoke to her/him [Nellie] a few weeks later, and s/he [Nellie] said s/he [Nellie] didn't know what I was talking about.
28 29 30	Q:	Do you believe her/him [Nellie]?
31 32 33 34	A:	Look, I don't know what you want me to say. S/he's [Nellie] my mother/father. S/he has her moments, but s/he's really a good person. I can't tell you anything about that. I wasn't on the phone.
35 36	Q:	I'm curious, then, why wouldn't you tell the process server about the call?
37 38 39	A:	I don't know. I've never dealt with a process server before, and s/he seemed all official.
40 41	Q:	When did you speak to your mother last?
41 42 43	A:	A few weeks after the server came by, early December, I guess.
44 45	Q:	And before then, when was the last time you spoke to her?

1 2 3 4 5 6 7	A:	I saw her a few times in November. S/he [Nellie] stopped by the house a few times to get some stuff. S/he [Nellie] had dad's/mom's Mustang while s/he was away for about a week. Before then, sometime in June. S/he [Nellie] went on one of her "trips" s/he would disappear for months. I think s/he said s/he had a trip planned in South America from June to July.
8 9 10	Q:	I'd like to change subjects a little bit and talk to you about your use of social media. Do you have a Facebook account?
10 11 12	A:	Of course, who doesn't?
13 14	Q:	What is your username?
15 16	A:	BALLER99
17 18	Q:	What does that stand for her, if anything?
19 20 21 22	A:	I listen to a lot of rap growing up. I'm a big fan of Lil' Troy. You know, "I wanna be a Baller, Shot Caller Twenty inch blades" I was born in 1999.
23 24	Q:	OK. Do you ever use your mother's/father's [Nellie] account?
25 26 27	A:	Sometimes. I used to help her/him [Nellie] out because s/he wasn't very tech savvy, so I set up all of her/his profiles and passwords.
28 29 30	Q:	How many profiles does your mother/father [Nellie] have? Let me back up, when you say profiles, do you mean Facebook?
31 32	A:	Yes, Facebook, s/he has two I believe. KickA\$\$ and KickOverArmorA\$\$.
33 34	Q:	Did you set both of them up?
35 36 37	A:	I did. Like I said, s/he [Nellie] is not very tech savvy and s/he needed me to help her with it.
38 39	Q:	Do you have the passwords?
40 41 42	A:	I think so. 20inchblades is the password for KickA\$\$, and I believe ShotCaller is the password for KickOverArmorA\$\$.
43 44	Q:	Thank you. What is the last time that you logged in to either of the two accounts?
45 46	A:	It's been a while, I'm not certain.

1	Q:	Have you ever logged into her accounts to post any messages?
3	A:	Never.
4 5	Q:	Did you give your mother/father [Nellie] the passwords?
6 7 8	A:	Yes. I think it was in November, the day after a really big concert. A Sunday, I believe.
9 10 11	Q:	I'm going to show you what I've marked as Exhibit 2, do you recognize this?
12 13 14	A:	This looks like an e-mail I sent my mother/father [Nellie] with her/his new account information.
15 16 17	Q:	Why did you send it?
18 19	A:	Because s/he [Nellie] asked me to create new accounts, so I did and I sent her/him the account information.
20 21 22	Q:	Other than this email, did you send any other emails from the kickwood2@kmail.com account?
23 24 25	A:	Nope. Never.
26 27	Q:	Are you positive?
28 29	A:	Absolutely.
30 31	Q:	Back to Exhibit 2, why send the email if you had already given your mother/father [Nellie] the password back in November?
32 33 34	A: Q:	I think s/he asked me to send it to her/him. I don't remember. Okay, what about your mother's/father's [Nellie] Facebook account, ever use that?
35 36 37	A:	Nope. What s/he [Nellie] does is none of my business.
38 39	Q:	Are you sure?
40 41	A:	Absolutely.
42 43 44	Q:	I am going to show you what's been marked as Exhibit 4, do you recognize this?
44 45 46	A:	Yes, it's a text from me to my mother/father [Nellie].

1	Q:	Did you send it?
2 3 4	A:	Yes
5 6	Q:	What is the Life is Beautiful Festival?
7 8 9	A:	A concert I went to in November last year. Snoop Dogg was there. Great concert.
10 11	Q:	That concert was on November 8, 2014, wasn't it?
12 13	A:	If you say so. That night is a little foggy, if you know what I mean.
14 15	Q:	But you were there, correct?
16 17	A:	I just told you I was.
18 19	Q:	Who is Jimmy B?
20 21	A:	One of my buddies.
22 23 24	Q:	Were you with Jimmy B at the Snoop Dogg concert on November 8, 2014?
25 26	A:	I don't know when it was, but, yes, I was with Jimmy B.
27 28	Q:	And Suz?
29 30	A:	Yeah, she was there.
31 32 33	Q:	Is this the concert you referred to earlier, when you gave your mother/father [Nellie] the password for the new accounts?
34 35	A:	Yes.
36 37	Q:	I am going to hand you Exhibit 5, ever see this?
38 39 40	A:	No. Ha is this a joke? That looks like a Facebook chat, but I've never seen it. Did you make that up?
41 42	Q:	I don't understand, what do you mean?
43 44 45 46	A:	I see what you're trying to do. You are trying to set me up. I did not post this on Facebook using my mother's/father's [Nellie] profile. Nice try. Look at the date. It says November 10th, but the concert was on November 8th and we were hanging in the morning of the 9th.

1	Q:	Please take a look at Exhibit 6. Do you know who wrote the post using
2		KickOverArmorA\$\$ on September 5, 2014, at 11:58 p.m.?
3		
4	A:	No, I don't. I know that you guys think that I was posting this stuff to try
5		to get my mother/father [Nellie] in trouble, but it's not true, ok?
6		Seriously, s/he's a whack job. Who knows why s/he did it.
