FAQ May 2023 Graduation

Commencement will take place on Saturday, May 13, 2023.

There will be on ceremony starting at 8:30am.

Q: Will the 10-guest maximum for on campus Commencement change based on the number of graduates who RSVP?

A: No, the 10-guest maximum will not change. Guest wristbands will be distributed with graduation cords during the Student Affairs tabling events in May prior to Commencement.

Q: Can I use someone else's 10-guest wristbands if they aren't going to bring guests to the ceremony?

A: Yes. Graduates not attending are permitted to share their guest wristbands with other graduates. Students work this out amongst themselves, there is no formal ticket swap.

Q: Will there be a place on campus for my other guests (above the 10 wristbands) to watch the ceremony?

A: No. All Commencement Ceremonies will be livestreamed. The link for the livestream will be on the College of Law main web page the day of Commencement.

Q: Does my legacy presenter count toward the 10-guest maximum?

A: No, the legacy presenter(s) do not count toward the 10-guest maximum because they are seated behind the Faculty. Please contact the Dean's Office at <u>lawdean@law.stetson.edu</u> with any questions regarding legacy participation at the graduation ceremony.

Q: Is there a chance Commencement will be cancelled?

A: Commencement plans are contingent upon the weather and is subject to change at any point between now and May 13, 2023.

Q: What if there is inclement weather on the day of Commencement?

A: In case of inclement weather, we will move to the alternate location of First Baptist Church, 1900 Gandy Blvd N, St. Petersburg, FL. Graduates will be advised via email as well as the College of Law homepage. The ceremony will begin at 10:00 a.m. Should we move to the alternate site, graduates will be limited to **FOUR** guests.

Q: When will I receive my regalia?

A: You will receive notice from the Office of Career and Professional Development in April when your regalia has arrived and is available for pick-up.

The cutoff date of February 24, 2023 was set to guarantee delivery in time for the ceremony.

Q: When will I receive my cords?

A: The Office of Student Affairs will distribute cords at tabling events on Tuesday, May 9 and Wednesday, May 10, 10:00am – 6:00pm outside the Student Affairs office.

Q: When will I receive my wristbands and alternate site tickets?

A: Guest wristbands and alternate site tickets will be distributed with graduation cords at a tabling event hosted by the Office of Student Affairs on Tuesday, May 9 and Wednesday, May 10, 10:00am – 6:00pm.

Q: When are Composite Pictures taking place?

A: Composite photos will take place on May 9 and May 10.
