<b>Testing / Assessment Plan</b>	No testing or assessment plan is in place; instructions for student learning activities or assignments are missing or unclear	Students will be evaluated through objective testing only; assessments may not align with stated learning objectives; assignments and activities include instructions	In addition to objective testing, course includes some subjective assessments (discussions, homework, papers, projects); most assessments align with stated learning objectives; assignments and activities include clear instructions	Students will be evaluated through both objective and subjective assessments; all assessments align with stated learning objectives; opportunities for self- and peer-assessment are provided; assignments and activities include detailed, clear instructions

- information on the Discussions area
- participation expectations
- link to UTTC technical requirements webpage
- link to UTTC technical support webpage
- information on student resources, including the digital library
- course/instructor policies (missed exams or assignments, etc.)
- university policies (academic dishonesty, etc.)
- copyright statement

- course outline
- course calendar or schedule, including assignments, checkpoints and due dates
- netiquette guide
- roles and responsibilities
