





Call for Papers: 20th International Wildlife Law Conference (IWLC-20) April 1–2, 2020

The **20th International Wildlife Law Conference** will be held **April 1–2, 2020,** at Stetson University College of Law in Gulfport, Florida, USA. The conference will be hosted by the **Institute for Biodiversity Law and Policy at Stetson University College of Law** and will be co-sponsored by the **Environmental Law Center at the University of Cologne** and the **University of Barcelona Faculty of Law**. IWLC-20 will bring together a variety of professionals involved in wildlife conservation, including lawyers, policymakers, and scientists. Student attendance and participation are strongly encouraged.

This event welcomes not only law professionals and students with an interest in wildlife, but also wildlife professionals and students with an interest in law.

IWLC-20 will include papers on a range of legal and policy frameworks related to wildlife protection and conservation. Papers are invited on the following aspects of international and regional wildlife law and policy:

- Species reintroduction and rewilding
- > Invasive species: challenges and solutions
- Legal and ethical issues related to trophy hunting
- Conservation of marine biodiversity
- > Impacts of climate change on wildlife treaties
- > Responses to the IPBES Global Assessment
