Security Deposit: A refundable deposit held to cover the costs of outstanding fees and damages that includes: damages attributable to an individual resident; unidentified damages that occur in their individual college and/or general shared community damages. Returning residents may elect to roll over existing Security Deposit.

Academic Development Levy: A once only contribution made by new residents towards the cost of existing and future facilities and academic related programs and services in University Residences. Not refundable. Not applicable for returning residents.

Student Club Levy: Annual contribution by all residents to recreation facilities, social activities, and the orientation program. Not refundable. The levy is being collected on behalf of the Student Village Students Club for social, sporting and related activities. Half fee applies for Semester Contract.

FAQs

Internet? Of course! The Student Village has a wireless connection throughout and each room has a modem for high speed broadband internet connection. The costs of the internet are included in your weekly accommodation fee.

I would like to accept my offer and pay the Acceptance Fee, how do I do this? You can do this by coming into the Service Centre (open Monday to Friday from 8:45am – 4:30pm), by telephone (+61 3 9304 6300) by Direct Debit (just complete the Direct Debit form that was sent with the contract) or the internet (www.vu.edu.au/residences).

How far from the University is the Student Village? Getting to VU is really easy. We have trams and buses which run connect to all the VU campuses. If you are coming home after 5pm on a weekday, you can even jump on the free Security Shuttle Bus! If you have a car there is plenty of at all the VU campuses (and you can park for FREE at the Student Village!)

I only want to stay for less than one semester, is that possible? Yes! We have short term contracts available, minimum stay two weeks (one week for returning TAFE students). Fees start from \$35 per night (internet available upon request). You can call us on +61 3 9304 6300 or email us at student.village@vu.edu.au and we can explain this in more detail.

Help! I've run out of food! We are lucky enough to be in walking distance to Highpoint, the second largest shopping centre in Melbourne. Where you can purchase food, clothing, mobile phones, bedding... actually, if you need to buy something, you'll find it all there!
