Appointments Committee Meeting

I. Written notice of the meeting having been sent to members of the faculty at least seven days in advance, and with a quorum being present, Professor Radwan called the meeting to order at 11:04a.m.

II. Minutes from the appointments committee meeting held on September 15, 2010, were approved by unanimous voice vote.

III. Report on applications and recruiting

a. **Update on Faculty Recruitment Conference:**

- Professor Radwan informed the faculty the Appointments Screening Committee has been meeting on a regular basis in anticipation of the October 29-30 AALS Recruitment Conference in Washington, D.C. Stetson will interview candidate in two rooms and all available time slots are filled.

b. **Anticipated Hiring Needs:**

- Stetson is seeking two tenure or tenure-track candidates in a combination of the areas of Property, Civil Procedure, and Constitutional Law. Stetson is also seeking one VAP, who will overlap the two existing Bruce Jacob VAPs, which will ultimately create a junior and senior VAP. The Committee is focusing on finding a Research and Writing candidate for this VAP position. The Committee is also seeking a Director of Clinics and Internships, which has been advertised as a standard tenure-track position, with a doctrinal component.

c. **On-campus visit schedule:**



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- IV. **Discussion of Voting Procedures** - Professor Radwan discussed the two procedures that will be used for voting for new faculty candidates. The two processes differ only with respect to whether there is a single faculty position or multiple faculty positions available and the process for eliminating candidates from the ballot.
