

## Curriculum Committee Minutes

September 13, 2010

The committee discussed and took action on the following proposals:

1. Circuit Civil Mediation Skills Training

The Florida Supreme Court now allows non-attorneys to gain this certification, but requires that it be completed as a separate course from other mediation training certifications. The committee discussed options for avoiding duplication of course credit. After some discussion the committee APPROVED and recommended that Dean Adams be allowed to decide whether students can take both mediation training courses for credit.

2. John Cooper introduced the International Programs curriculum for the upcoming sessions. The following courses were approved as part of that curriculum:

- a. Overview of European Union Competition Law – 1 credit, graded, in English
- b. Off-Shore Tax Havens & Financial Centres – 1 credit
- c. Economic Development in the Caribbean – Global Initiatives – 1 credit
- d. Comparative Legal Profession – 1 credit
- e. Introduction to International Sports Law – 1 credit
- f. Comparative Contract Law – 1 credit
- g. Denationalization of Economics Sectors in China – 1 credit
- h. Truth Commissions: Exploring Argentina's Legal Approach to Human Rights Abuse – 1 credit
- i. Legal Issues Involving Argentina's "Disappeared" Including Rights of Adopted Children and Their Biological Grandparents – 1 credit
