Feeling the Squeeze: Saving Biodiversity on a Shrinking Natural Landscape

Urban sprawl is rapidly consuming Florida's natural landscape while sea level rise is steadily inundating the coasts, working independently and synergistically to threaten many of Florida's rare and imperiled species. This lecture will describe how sprawl, sea level rise, and coastal squeeze threaten endangered and threatened species; illustrate efforts to protect these species from these threats using the Endangered Species Act; and describe how the public can directly engage in critical conservation work.
