Scientist, professor, and author Jennifer Jaquet will discuss the scientific and ethical arguments against octopus farming and efforts at the state and federal levels to stop the mass production of octopuses.



Jennifer Jaquet is a Professor of Environmental Science and Policy at the Rosenstiel School of Marine, Atmospheric, and Earth Science at the University of Miami, and affiliated faculty with the Abess Center for Ecosystem Science and Policy. From 2012-2022, she worked in the Department of Environmental Studies at New York University. She authored *Is Shame Necessary* (Pantheon, 2015) and *The Playbook* (Pantheon, 2022).
