**North American Regional Round  
2017–2018**

- A. The 2017–2018 North American Regional Round will be a memorial-based qualifying round.
- B. The round is open to teams from Canada and the United States. See the *Rules for the Twenty-Second Annual Stetson International Environmental Moot Court Competition 2017–2018: International Finals* [hereinafter *International Finals Rules*] for the requirements regarding team composition.
- C. Only one memorial may be submitted per school. A school may choose to host an internal competition within that school to determine which team will submit a memorial for the North American Regional Round.
- D. Teams must register for the North American Regional Round by 5:00 p.m. EST (Eastern Standard Time) on Friday, October 20, 2017. Teams should email Professor Brooke Bowman at [bowman@law.stetson.edu](mailto:bowman@law.stetson.edu) to register.
- E. Teams must prepare and submit memorials in accordance with the *International Finals Rules*. Each team must submit **either** an Applicant or Respondent memorial by 5:00 p.m. EST (Eastern Standard Time) on Friday, November 17, 2017. A team may choose to write for either the Applicant or the Respondent.
- F. Memorials will be graded in accordance with the *International Finals Rules*. Based solely on the memorial scores, up to the top four teams from Canada and up to the top four teams from the United States will advance to the International Finals.
- G. There is no registration fee to participate in the 2017–2018 North American Regional Round, but teams advancing to the International Finals must pay a registration fee in accordance with Rule J(5) of the *International Finals Rules*.
