After Hours Access

To use either the Tampa or the Gulfport Law Library after hours, you must complete an "After Hours Law Library Access Request Form" (available at the circ desks) prior to the Law Library closing time, and you must have the form signed by a library staff member. If no staff member is available, the form can be signed by a student worker.



TAMPA

- You must be in the Law Library at closing time.
- You may not admit anyone else to the Tampa building after closing time.
- You may not prop open the building door in Tampa.
- You must act appropriately when in the Law Library, disposing of trash, being considerate of other users, and assisting in maintaining the cleanliness of all facilities.
- You may use the balcony on the 2nd floor if you wish to smoke. If you leave the Tampa Campus building you will not be readmitted.

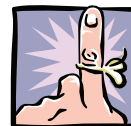


GULFPORT

- You must be in the Law Library at closing time.
- You may not admit anyone else to the Library after closing time.
- You may not prop open the Law Library door in Gulfport.
- You must act appropriately when in the Law Library, disposing of trash, being considerate of other users, and assisting in maintaining the cleanliness of all facilities.
- You must remain in the Law Library. If you leave the Law Library you will not be readmitted.
