Choir Restructure Information

*There is an intentional overlap in the ages and grades with the Apprentice Choir and Young Singers.

Singers develop at different rates vocally and behaviorally. Also, there are singers that have been a part of the SYS family for multiple years, providing them with vocal skill and training. Singers that are new to us should register in the Apprentice Choir through 8th grade age.

For clarification on scheduling singers or assigning multiple singers from the same family to different choirs, please contact me.

Returning singers, as you discuss choir names and assignments, note that ensemble age ranges have changed, while the ensemble names remain the same. Singers might worry about choir placement, but rest assured that changes are because of the growth of the choir, and all ensembles will be given music that challenges that level of singer correctly.

For more help with placement or to meet the director and learn more about the choir, you may request to schedule a voice placement interview.
