To help ensure that our camp will be a successful one, we ask that you please do the following every day you are with us:

- Arrive at the Stetson School of Music lobby between 8:30 and 9:00am

- Sign in/receive a name tag and meet in room 132. We will be there to guide you!
- Bring a water bottle (please make sure it is labeled with your child's name)
- Bring a snack and a lunch
- Wear comfortable clothes and closed toe shoes (no flip flops please)
- We begin at 9am and will dismiss at 3:00pm. Please be on time for pick up.

*Small Voices (5-7 years) - Your camp times are 8:30-11:30 am daily. You'll need to bring a snack daily, but not lunch. If you have children enrolled in both the Small Voices half day camp and Young Singers camp (8-18 years), you may drop off all children between 8:15 and 8:30am. Your concert will be at 11:30 and is free and open to all.

The Young Singers Concert will be on Friday, July 18th at 4:30 pm. Young Singers will stay on campus until after the concert that Friday. They will need to wear their camp t-shirt all day on Friday so they have it on for the performance. Parents, family, Small Voices singers and friends are welcome to attend these performances. Free to all!

Presser Hall (the School of Music building) is located on Michigan Ave. Which is one street South of Minnesota Ave. where the main gates are. You can see Presser Hall immediately upon turning east-bound onto Michigan Ave. You will take a left into the Presser parking lot which is across from the Lynn Business Center.

***Because of construction, you will instead take a right into the parking lot beside the Lynn Business Center. On the first day, please be prepared to walk your singer to the door to sign them in. Follow the signs to walk to the School of Music and we'll be waiting for you there.**

- Small Voices (ages 5-7)
- Discovery Choir (ages 8-10)
- Apprentice Choir (ages 11-13)
- Young Singers (ages 14-18)

There are four ensembles that will rehearse together during this week-long camp. Singers will remain with their ensemble throughout the week. But they will also work and play all together in larger ensembles. It will be a mix of rehearsals that will encourage growth and build community in the special way that multi aged choirs can.

**The first day of camp is always a sorting day, and we're very flexible. We consider experience, age, friends, and enrollment numbers to create the four smaller ensembles. We're glad to keep friends and family together any way that we can. The main goal is to have great sounding ensembles with singers that love being there!*

We know that some singers start the week without knowing anyone at camp, and we'll do our best to make sure they leave feeling like part of a choir family. It's our hope that our campers will join us for the fall and spring semesters to sing with us year-round; however, we also welcome and value singers who return for the summer camp every year. Every singer is an important part of the ensemble.
