WHAT TO BRING

- *** Drinking water or container to hold drinking water. ***
- Yoga Mat or Towel for laying on floor
- Instrument(s), current method books, solos and ensembles, your own metronome and tuner if you own either/both, and any other supplies or music related to the flute.

If you have access and permission to borrow a working alto or bass flute and wish to play it, please bring it with you. We will use the auxiliary instruments for the chamber ensembles and flute choirs.

- FOLDING MUSIC STAND. Stetson University stands are limited, and we cannot guarantee a stand will be provided. Please remember to put your name on all parts of the stand.
- Casual clothes, comfortable shoes, athletic wear, etc. are suitable for daily activities; pajamas and a robe would be suitable for evenings in the dorm. A sweater or jacket is suggested, as the buildings tend to be cold. Students are expected to "dress up" for the evening concerts – no blue jeans, shorts, or casual flip-flops. CONCERT DRESS is black skirt or pants (black socks and black shoes) with a white blouse or top for the ladies (NOT sleeveless); black dress pants (black socks and shoes) with a white shirt and appropriate tie for the gentlemen.
- Towels, washcloths, hangers, hand soap, toiletries, sunscreen, raincoat or umbrella, twin size sheets (XL), pillow, blankets (dorms are often cold at night), alarm clock, etc.
- Spending money (\$30 \$50 should be plenty). All admissions, lessons, and meals are pre-paid in the tuition/dorm fee. The bookstore is open for souvenirs, there is a snack shop/coffee shop available on campus, students may order pizza/take-out at night. PLEASE DO NOT BRING LARGE AMOUNTS OF CASH.
- Board games, cards, hand-held video games, etc. are acceptable for free time in the afternoon or before lights out, but we discourage bringing expensive recreational items to the camp. The camp/university is not responsible for items lost or stolen during the duration of the camp, so if you choose to bring electronic items please be responsible in the use and care for said item.
- Part of the camp experience is being away from home. We would like to discourage the use of cell phones during the week unless it is an emergency. Cell phone use is not permitted in rehearsals and concerts.
