Stetson University Flute Workshop 2024 Video Audition Instructions

Dear Flute Workshop Participant,

Before you prepare your audition video, read through all these instructions carefully.

- You may use a phone/tablet. You may also use a camera attached to your computer. Be sure to test your recording level, picture placement, etc. to get the best recording you can.
- 2. Make sure we can see you, as well as your hands/fingers throughout the video.
- 3. Practice recording yourself a few times before you plan to send a recording. All students should send their audition recordings by June 10.
- 4. All students should record the audition excerpt, including repeats, in its entirety. If the etude is difficult for your level, just do the best you can!
- 5. 7th-9th grade students should record 4 scales: F major, B-flat major, E-flat major, and the chromatic scale in as many octaves as possible.
- 6. 10th-12th grade students should record 7 scales: B-flat major, E-flat major, A-flat major, D-flat major, A major, D major, and the chromatic scale in as many octaves as possible.
- 7. To audition on **piccolo**, please record the same audition excerpt on piccolo.
- 8. When you are done recording your video, upload the completed video to YouTube, and set the privacy to "Unlisted."
- 9. Please review your video once it is uploaded to make sure it is visible, and the sound is audible.
- 10. Email the unlisted YouTube link to Dr. Phillips: tkphilli@stetson.edu by June 10.

VIDEO RECORDING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. First, introduce yourself: First name, last name.
- 2. Say "I am entering grade next school year."
- 3. Play your assigned scales.
- 4. Play your assigned audition excerpt.
- 5. If you are auditioning on piccolo, record the same excerpt on piccolo.
- 6. Upload your video to YouTube and set the privacy to "Unlisted."
