



Rules

1. Students must attend all rehearsals, classes, and performances as specified on their schedule.
2. Students may be assigned to play soprano, alto, tenor, or baritone saxophone in an ensemble, even if it is their first time on that instrument. Assignments are made by staff based on the needs of the workshop.
3. Students may not leave Stetson campus during the workshop. This includes meals with friends, family members, or relatives. In an emergency, students may leave with a chaperone approved by the director. Students who drive themselves must turn in their keys to staff at check-in.
4. Students must be accompanied by a staff member at all times on campus and must keep staff informed of their whereabouts.
5. Curfew and lights-out times will be announced on the first day. Students must be in their assigned rooms by curfew.
6. Students may not have visitors in their dorm rooms without approval from the director. Students of different genders are not permitted in each other's rooms or hallways.
7. Students must set phones and devices to Do Not Disturb or turn them off during rehearsals. Devices may be used between activities.
8. Students are responsible for their personal belongings and any materials provided by staff. Students may not use or disturb the belongings of others without permission.
9. Students will be charged \$75 for each lost FOB or dorm room key, payable at checkout.
10. Bullying, harassment, and intimidation are not tolerated. Violators will be immediately dismissed at the student's family's expense.
11. Smoking, alcohol, drugs, firearms, fireworks, and candles are prohibited. Violators will be immediately dismissed at the student's family's expense.
12. Students who feel ill must notify a staff member immediately. Medical emergencies will be handled through through local medical providers and emergency services as appropriate. Students must submit the Informed Consent form at check-in.
