**RULES and REGULATIONS**

- Students are expected to be at all events unless officially excused by a faculty member or the camp director.
- STUDENTS MAY NOT LEAVE THE STETSON CAMPUS. This includes going out to eat with parents or relatives, unless prior arrangements have been made and approved by the camp director. In the event of an emergency, students may leave campus with a chaperone that is approved by the camp director.
- Smoking, alcoholic beverages, other chemical abuse, firearms, fireworks, or explosive devices will not be allowed under any circumstances. Violators of this regulation will be immediately dismissed from the clinic at parental expense.
- Visitors (anyone not attending the camp) are not allowed in the Residence Hall.
- Campers assigned to rooms on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the Residence Hall are only permitted on floor 1.
- Campers assigned to rooms on the 2nd floor of the Residence Hall are only permitted on floor 2 and the Commons Room prior to “lights out” times.
- Students will be held responsible for their personal belongings as well as materials issued by the faculty. Students are expected not to use or disturb the belongings of others without permission. Stetson University is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Cell phones will not be allowed in rehearsals, classes, or concerts.
- Any medical emergencies will be handled through Stetson Public Safety, Campus Health Services, and Advent Health Hospital in DeLand. **Each camper must have completed the Informed Consent Form** prior to registration on the first day of camp.
- There will be a \$100 charge per residence hall FOB for lost room FOBS.
- Stetson University Public Safety is available 24 hours a day, and the campus is patrolled on a regular basis. Public Safety's number is **(386) 822-7300**. In addition, call boxes (identified by blue lights) are located at many points around campus for emergencies.

Students are expected to exercise good judgment at all times and look out for each other as well as themselves.
